The Poverty Point Culture

Before the first Europeans arrived in North America, there was a population of eight million or more **Indigenous** Americans living throughout the continent. These Indigenous Americans had been in North America for centuries. At the time of contact with the Europeans, there were hundreds of independent nations with different languages and government structures living across the entire continent. These nations had developed diverse cultures, agricultural practices, and trading networks. They had built complex social systems and rich oral traditions, passing down their knowledge and history through storytelling.

During the Archaic Period (around 8000 to 1000 BCE), there were many small hunter-gatherer groups living in present-day Louisiana. Many of these groups built hill-like mounds,
